BE SAFE AT SEA. FREE SAFETY & SURVIVAL TRAINING FOR COMMERCIAL FISHERMEN

MAY 17TH IN GLOUCESTER

On Friday, May 17, 2013, a free safety and survival training will be held at the Coast Guard Station, 17 Harbor Loop, Gloucester from 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM. The hands-on training, sponsored by Fishing Partnership Support Services, is conducted by Coast Guard certified fishing vessel safety instructors.

The Safety-at-Sea training program includes:

- On-Board Firefighting
- Man-Overboard Procedures
- Flooding & Pump Procedures
- Flares & EPIRBs
- Donning & Using Survival Suits
- Life Raft Deployment
- Damage Control
- Emergency Communication/First Aid

Please bring your own survival suits. Training suits are provided for those who do not currently have one.
