SMALL ENTITY COMPLIANCE GUIDE

Dear Northeast (NE) Multispecies Days-at-Sea Permit Holder:

This letter is to inform you that **zero trips are authorized into the Closed Area (CA) II Yellowtail Flounder Special Access Program (SAP) for the 2008 fishing year** (i.e., through April 30, 2009). A notice explaining the details of this action will be published in the Federal Register on June 4, 2008.

Framework Adjustment 40-B to the NE Multispecies Fishery Management Plan authorizes the Regional Administrator to determine, in consultation with the New England Fishery Management Council (Council), the number of trips that will be allowed into the CA II Yellowtail Flounder SAP for each fishing year. This determination is made by considering the yearly total allowable catch (TAC) for Georges Bank (GB) yellowtail flounder, the potential catch of GB yellowtail flounder by vessels fishing outside of the SAP, recent discard estimates, and the expected number of SAP participants. If the available catch of GB yellowtail flounder, after considering the amount of GB yellowtail flounder caught outside of the SAP, is not enough to support at least 150 trips into the SAP with a possession limit of 15,000 lb of GB yellowtail flounder per trip (i.e., is less than 1,021 mt), the Regional Administrator may choose not to authorize any trips into the SAP during that fishing year.

Because the GB yellowtail flounder TAC is only 1,950 mt for the 2008 fishing year, the Regional Administrator has determined, after consulting with the Council, that there is not enough GB yellowtail flounder to support any trips into the CA II Yellowtail Flounder SAP during the 2008 fishing year.
