

## FY15 JEA ALWTRP Annual report

A total of \$142,458.20 was transferred to the following states: ME, MA, NH, RI and NJ. A total of \$1,377.36 was not utilized and funds have expired. This funding obligated 1,631 total at sea personnel and vessel hours and 52 air personnel and plane hours. The cost for personnel and vessels are pre determined within the JEA by utilizing salary tables and manufacture burn rates of fuel and oil. A total of 3,918.5 at sea personnel, vessel hours and 56 air personnel and plane hours were completed. All additional hours were provided by the states with NO reimbursement. A total of 936 (increase in 213 Contacts from FY14) contacts were made. Work is completed year round.
