The total allowable catches (TACs) for the access areas are as follows: Closed Area I 177,490 lb; Nantucket Lightship 177,490 lb; Hudson Canyon 532,460 lb; Delmarva (closed June 13, 2012) 177,490 lb. The TACs apply to all IFQ vessels, including IFQ vessels that also have a limited access scallop permit. The LAGC fishery is not monitored relative to the access area TACs.
