The total allowable catches (TACs) for the access areas are as follows: Nantucket Lightship 357,200 lb; Hudson Canyon 535,800 lb. The TACs apply to all IFQ vessels, including IFQ vessels that also have a limited access scallop permit. The LAGC fishery is not monitored relative to the access area TACs.
